Subject: Remote Learning

On November 30, 2020 all Nazareth ISD students will return to on-campus, face-to-face instruction. Long-term remote instruction will no longer be an option as of this date. If your child is currently enrolled in long-term remote instruction he/she may stay remote until November 30, 2020 or may return any time before then. All NISD students will be expected to return to on-campus instruction no later than Monday, November 30, 2020.

The only exceptions will be the following:

- Those students who are required to quarantine/isolate due to close contact exposure or a positive COVID-19 test result.
- Students who are sick with other illnesses but still able to participate in instruction.
- On a case-by-case basis for certain special education students and students with Section 504 accommodations.

While we strongly believe that on-campus instruction at Nazareth ISD is the best choice for all students, parents have options to consider. If you do not want your child to return to campus you may:

- Call other districts to seek enrollment/transfer
- Homeschool
- Enroll with an online school (two examples given below)
 - K-12 online (www.k12.com) Free
 - TTU K-12 (<http://www.depts.ttu.edu/k12/>) Tuition required

If you decide that one of these options best fits your child's needs, please contact Mr. O'Connor to complete the required paperwork indicating your decision.
